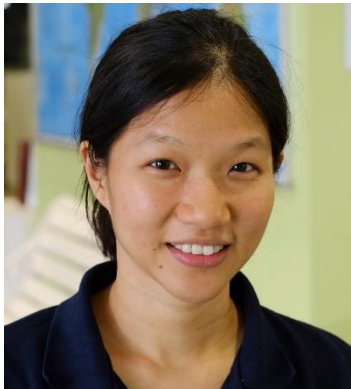




KAREN ANG
